What is a Home Care Package?




A Home Care Package is a flexible in-home support option designed to provide a wide variety of services and products for older people. There are four levels available. Each level provides a different subsidy amount that can be used to fund services to meet your care needs.

Home Care Package (HCP)



Level 1 -	\$10,271	annually
Level 2 -	\$18,063	annually
Level 3 -	\$39,310	annually
Level 4 -	\$ 59,953	annually

With Care Connect you receive your own Care Manager.

A Home Care Package is structured in four different levels as everyone's care needs are different.

A formal application is required through My Aged Care. You may need to wait for up to 12+ months for a Home Care Package to be assigned.

Your HCP level is assigned based on your circumstances.

Formal care plans must document individual goals as part of your HCP. All support and services must then align with personal goals in your care plan.

As your circumstances change it is possible to request a review for a higher level of funding.

Care plans are formally reviewed annually and subsidies are reviewed 1 July each year.
